- 9.) Our hospitality room, social at the Bluegrass Pizza & Pub, interaction with our Lecture Staff, and the experience to share ideas during our Match Analysis is unique to this camp. You will have plenty of opportunity to network while enjoying yourself in a fun camp environment.
